- He has a unique view and knowledge of the Czech Republic and Prague history in the Communist era, especially the **infamous StB, Communist State Security** aka (Secret) Police force.
- What was it like to grow up at this time? How difficult was your life when you were part of the **dissent and resistance**? Aleš will share stories about people who experiences oppression during the former regime
- We'll visit the feared **Bartholomew Street** – **former HQ of StB** and **other sites around CET** such as Národní třída, Újezd and Malá Strana
